(Avoid cartoon/character/odd shapes because the thumb drive won't fit in laptops.)  
(Students need home-access to parent-supervised computers.)
5. #2 Lead Pencils with Erasers (Box of a Dozen - replenish as needed)
6. 1 regular rectangular Eraser and 1 White Art Eraser
7. Ballpoint Pens (2 Blue/Black; 2 Red; No Gel-Type)
8. 3 Black Dry-Erase Markers and Eraser (no board needed)
9. Cray Pas<sup>®</sup> (at *Longs*<sup>®</sup>) (12 count only)
10. Colored Pencils (12 count)
11. 2 Black Sharpies (Fine Point)
12. 1 Pointed Scissors (Good Quality)
13. Watercolors (Tray of 8 Colors with Brush)

3. Composition Books (5 standard, not spiral-bound, hard covers)
4. #2 Lead Pencils with erasers (12 pre-sharpened & 12 unsharpened;  
put name or initials on each pencil)
5. 1 White Art Eraser and 1 Regular Eraser
6. Pencil Case (1 standard-sized, must fit inside desk)
7. Ballpoint Pens (3 red and 5 Blue or Black) & Highlighter (1 Yellow or Orange)
8. Scissors (Good Quality, Pointed Tip)
9. White Glue (1 Bottle and 4 Glue Sticks)
10. Crayons (No More than a Box of 24)
11. Colored Pencils (No more than 12, Good Quality) & Black Sharpies<sup>®</sup> (2)
12. 5 black or blue wide-tip dry-erase markers
