SUMMER FUN for Preschool

REQUIREMENTS:

* must be 3 years old by June 1, 2015 (submit copy of birth certificate)

* must be completely and independently toilet trained.

* meet health requirements for TB Clearance

SUMMER PREP for Pre-K (entering kindergarten)/current K

Summer Prep is for current K students to continue learning while helping those entering K to prepare for the next level. They will work on their fine motor skills, phonics, alphabets, numbers, including art & cooking projects.

FEES: due with Enrollment Form Full Day: 6:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. \$1000

Half Day: 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon \$650

REQUIREMENTS:

* must be 5 years old by September 1, 2015 (submit copy of birth certificate)

* must be completely and independently toilet-toilet trained.

* meet health requirements for TB Clearance

* must be entering K in 2015 or just completed K

* have not yet entered grade 1

Fees for Summer Fun and Summer Prep include nutritious snacks and a daily balanced hot lunch from Opulicious, Inc. Cancellations, early withdrawals, vacations, or days absent will NOT receive refunds.

Half day students picked up after 12 noon will be assessed \$20 per hour or a part thereof until the 6:00 p.m. closing or \$50 flat rate for drop-in. Students not picked up before the 6:00 p.m. closing time will be charged \$10 per each 15-minute increment or a part thereof.

Parents must sign in PS, PK, & K students each morning upon arrival and sign them out when picking them up each afternoon. Other authorized adults must have a written not on file.

SUMMER SCHOOL for Grades 1-7

Summer School is for students who just completed Grades 1-7. They will study Math, English, Science and Life Skills.

FEES: \$750 due with Enrollment Form

DAY CARE (BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE: for Grades 1-7 Offered to students enrolled in our 4-week program. <u>Hours: Drop-off: 6:30 a.m. Pick-up by 6:00 p.m.</u> Please check-in and pick-up in Room 201. Lunch and afternoon snack are provided.

Additional Cost: \$450 due with Enrollment Form

CLASS SUMMARIES Grades 1-7

- **English:** Improving reading and language skills through discussions, vocabulary enrichment activities and grammar drills used to sharpen writing skills, paying special attention to organization, correct usage, effective presentation and proper paragraph development.
- *Math*: Intensive review of basic math (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fraction) taking it as far as the students can learn as appropriate for their grade.
- Science/Life Skills: Consists of interesting science experiments in which students can apply to real life situations. Gardening activities that focus on sustainability and life skills projects to sharpen child's social awareness to function in day to day.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

AFTER SCHOOL PICK-UP: Students must be picked by 11:30 a.m. with the exception of those who have a sibling in our Summer Fun and Summer Prep Program. These students may attend our day care program until 12 noon at no additional charge. They may bring home lunch if they wish to eat with their sibling. All other students remaining after will be admitted to our daycare

All other students remaining after will be admitted to our daycare program and charged the established daycare drop-in \$50 flat rate or assessed of \$20 per hour or a part thereof until the 6:00 p.m. closing. Students not picked up before the 6:00 p.m. closing time will be charged \$10 per each \$15-minute increment or a part thereof.

- **ASSIGNMENTS:** Students are expected to complete all class and home assignments and are responsible to obtain missed work after absence.
- **DRESS CODE**: Informal attire is appropriate for our summer session. T-shirts and shorts are acceptable if in **good taste and appropriate for a Christian school**. For the child's safety, shoes required no slippers.
- ABSENCES: Please call the school office (488-0000) before 8:15 a.m.
- **TARDIES:** Students reporting to school after 8:00 a.m. must report to the school office before going to class.
- **ILLNESS**: If a child becomes ill, the school office will attempt to contact a parent, family member or other authorized adult as listed on the enrollment form. Parents must take students home when they have temperatures over 99.5 degrees F.

PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES: Parents may arrange a conference with a teacher if desired.
